Chief's Report

Chief Burson reported that all of the Seville Police Department Officers have served the community professionally and have all returned home safely.

Chief Burson reviewed statistics for June. There were 56 traffic offenses and crashes. The Department had 28 assists to BOPA, Fire and EMS. Two domestic disputes and 22 suspicious persons, cars or circumstances.

Three new felonies, 27 misdemeanor offenses, 1 unclassified and 8 minor misdemeanor offences. Significant offenses included burglary, disorderly conduct, domestic violence, identity fraud, OVI, and multiple traffic. Five cleared by adult arrest and seven traffic citations. There are four investigations pending. Seven Male and two female new suspects developed. The offenses are coming from residences of Canton, Creston, Jeromesville, Seville, Sterling, and Wadsworth.

The officers participated in Criminal Patrol, Zuecher and CAD training due to the Medina County Sheriff's Office changing their system, and yard sale pre-event planning training during the month of June.

In June the major events included the yards sale. Officer Kilgore was sworn in and is doing a great job. Officers participated in Safety City at Cloverleaf Elementary. An officer assisted with a person in crisis found at the laundromat and taken to Medina Hospital for evaluation. Two shoplifters from Dollar General were arrested.
