1. Review site that was planned from the current trail over Chippewa Creek to Greenwich Road, then east to Village easement going north into Panther. A date of September 4th at 1:00 p.m. to walk the site from Ohio Wholesale to the proposed Bridge site.
2. Gordon said there is \$62,800 in the current account for the trails and there will be additional after the Labor Day race.
3. There was a discussion on what funding and/or grants are available.
 - a. Clean Ohio Fun Grant
 - b. Ohio Department of Recreation
 - c. Frontier Grant. (Will approach Medina Parks if they would like to partner to get a grant to connect a Ryan Road Trail with the Village at Greenwich Road.
 - d. Check with Police Chief on the military supplies on the off chance they would have a bridge available.
 - e. Find out what the current cost is different from the original projection.
4. Part of the easement agreement with Sugar Shack, the Grantor, to Seville, the Grantee, on stipulation was no fence shall be constructed. This was a question previously asked at a meeting.
5. Larry will check if there is a picture of the trail plan with Patty. If not he will make a copy of Bonnie's after the Labor Day Run.
