Chief Burson reported that all of the Seville Police Department Officers have served the community professionally and have all returned home safely. Chief Burson said the jail is now accepting prisoners for felonies. In July, during the reporting period, we logged 5,295 activities.

Officer Deal completed the Standard Field Sobriety Instructor Training. Officer Deal is certified to teach continuing education in OVI testing.

Another round of catalytic converters has been stolen. Officers have identified two individuals and are awaiting grand jury indictments. Chief Burson said it is difficult to come up with suspects. Our officers have served 7 search warrants in the last two months. Not every department can serve search warrants.

The breaking and entering investigations continues for stolen lawnmowers. A Creston man was indicted and arrested, and second individual has been indicted.
