The Chief of Police, Don Burson, recommended changing the current park sign. There are concerns of the residents confronting the police in regards to proving their rights. The Committee will recommend to Council to cover up the no weapon line on the park sign.

Barb Schwartz made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Larry Landis seconded the motion. All were in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
