



**Parks Committee Meeting Minutes
July 25, 2012**

Call to Order:

Chair Roger Kilgore called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m.

Roll Call:

Present were Chair Roger Kilgore, Barb Schwartz, Larry Landis, and Bonnie Gordon.

Absent: Sue Cox.

Approval of Minutes:

Larry Landis made a motion to approve the minutes of May 23, 2012, and the motion was seconded by Barb Schwartz. All were in favor. The minutes were approved with the correction that at the last meeting it was stated incorrectly that Daniel Chudzinski's donation was \$102.12. The correct amount is \$100.29.

Parks & Streets Commissioner's Report:

The attached report was submitted by Jon Sobczak. Mr. Sobczak also submitted the seal coating bids he has received. There was a discussion about the companies, the work to be done, and the budget. Bonnie Gordon made a motion to contract with Buckeye Seal Coating for asphalt seal coating to be done on Maria Stan Hope Park and Cy Hewit Park parking lot. The work is not to exceed \$11,000.00. Larry Landis seconded the motion. Aye votes all.

Privilege of the Floor:

Nancy Boomhower of Pin Oak Trail reported that she checked with Boyerts pricing on filled flower pots. The pots are resin and the large pot is \$220 and the smaller one is \$179. It is approximately \$80 to renew the pots. This includes storage, but there is an additional cost for delivery. There was a discussion of which locations would work the best.

Kathy Rhoads asked what kind of printer is needed for Mr. Sobczak. Mr. Sobczak will need a black and white printer.

New Business:

Bonnie Gordon and the Mayor have noticed the bricks need work at the Gazebo and brought photos to share. Barb Schwartz will check with Jim Carrick on the status of our Gazebo Repair Fund. Mrs. Gordon has \$1,200.00 in the Sancha & Chuck Lance fund that can be used.

New Business (cont):

Bonnie Gordon has been asked by Leslie Miller about money for expanding the trail. The Village Trail Fund has \$47,200. The Run for the Trails has \$33,055. Mrs. Gordon said they are very close to the amount needed to apply for a grant and asked if the Village is still interested in expanding the trail. It was discussed it would be beneficial to the Village to continue the process. After Run for the Trails they are expecting to be at \$85,000. The amount needed for the grant is \$94,000 to \$100,000 to have matching funds for the grant. If the Village would like to contribute approximately \$10,000 to \$15,000 would be needed to give enough for the grant. Mrs. Schwartz recommended to keep this up front as Mr. Stallard is working with ODOT. Mrs. Gordon announced the Run for the Trails will be September 3rd.

Old Business:

Mr. Sobczak was asked what information he could contribute to put in the kiosks at the parks for emergency information. Mr. Sobczak recommended a map of the trail should be included. Options of how to mark the trail were discussed. Mr. Sobczak will measure out the trail. This will be a work in progress.

Barb Schwartz has received information on the Port-A-Potty from Kathy Rhoads. The ADA compliant is available with rentals prices at \$170 for 28 days or \$139.98 plus \$10 for sanitizer. This would need to come from the park capital or park improvement budget line. There was a discussion on renting verse a more permanent structure. The Committee felt the permanent structure would be a good investment and would like to work it into the future budgets.

Barb Schwartz brought up the past discussions of lights for the parks flags. Leohr Park's solar light is burned out. Mrs. Schwartz would like this factored into next year's budet.

Mr. Sobczak had previously discussed the bleacher situation to Mrs. Schwartz. Mrs. Schwartz was wondering if new bleachers should come out of the playground budget. The Committee felt it was not necessary.

Mrs. Schwartz has sent Dan Buser's response to the Committee for playground risk assessment. Bonnie Gordon remembered that the Kiwanis has wanted to help in the past with playgrounds. Larry Landis will check with them.

Barb Schwartz and Jon Sobczak met yesterday and talked budgets. Mr. Sobczak has been very detailed with next year's budget. Mrs. Schwartz reported on the park capital equipment, contractual fund, park donations, tree replacement, and downtown decorations. The emergency fund is being eliminated. There was a discussion about decorations and donations. The budget will need to be approved by August.


