Mrs. Rhoads noted an e-mail that had been sent to all Council members concerning CivicPlus Inc. and their proposal to update the Village web-site. The initial cost would be \$3,000.00 with a \$1,500.00 fee each year thereafter for maintenance and upgrades. The intent of the update is to make the Village more attractive to potential businesses and residents. The price is higher than some committee members were prepared to spend until the number of people that actually use the web-site can be determined. The discussion will be added to the March Council agenda.

The use of an outside back-up service was discussed. The cost would be between \$2.00 and \$10.00 per month depending on the amount of space would be needed. Mrs. Rhoads moved to use the \$2.00 per month option. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Carter. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Demiter said he would work with the office staff to establish a standard naming convention for Village documents.

The discussion concerning the new Village logo will be added to the Government meeting in March.

**New Business:**

The Mayor noted the Guilford Assistant Fire Chief Byron Bombay had passed away. Mrs. Carter said she would find out what arrangements were being made.
