Chair Leslie Miller called to meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance

Roll Call:

Approval of Minutes:

Chief Burson reported that Officer Phillips had participated in the Torch Run. This was the first time the Seville Police Department was represented.

Chair Miller informed the Committee that Mrs. Bridenthal has suggested to add emergency information to the parks. There was a discussion about what information should be added to the Emergency Information list in the park's kiosks and pavilions. The Committee will defer the idea to the Parks Committee.

A CPR Class will be given by Denise Kisilewicz at the fire department on August 8th for the Village Employees. It was discussed that the AED in the office is checked by the fire department annually. The AED has a self-check indicator if the battery is low.

Chief Burson was asked about having to get the cars jumped. The Chief is working with Mr. Hall to find out what is draining the batteries.
