Chair Miller said that Sue Frey will get with Chief Burson for the Police Levy.

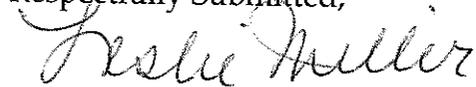
The quarterly report will be ready for the July meeting.
