Chair Leslie Miller called to meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance

Roll Call:

Leslie Miller, Roger Kilgore and Alternate Barb Schwartz. Kathy Rhoads arrived at 6:37 p.m.

Approval of Minutes:

Roger Kilgore made a motion to approve the minutes of May 23, 2012, as written and the motion was seconded by Barb Schwartz. All were in favor.

Privilege of the Floor:

Chair Miller gave Mr. Ogurchak the privilege of the floor. Chair Miller explained that Mr. Ogurchak wants to be allowed to bow hunt on his property which is located within the Village's limits. Mr. Ogurchak presented information from Village of Glen Willow, the Village of Granville, Sheffield, and Solon. These communities have the same laws and have adopted the bow hunting exception. Mr. Ogurchak also presented a license with a permission slip by the Ohio Game Commission, and after research Mr. Ogurchak discovered the bow hunters do not need to be tested. There was further discussion on the information presented. Chair Miller said that the Council and the Police Chief are not for this change. At this time the Committee will not allow the bow hunting request. Chair Miller did ask Mr. Ogurchak to please feel free to bring in new information as discovered.

Kathy Rhoads asked permission to join the meeting and permission was granted. Mrs. Schwartz will check with Ted Lesiak on the proper procedure when a member is joining the Committee after a meeting has started.

National Night Out. There is no new information at this time.


