



Safety Committee Minutes
November 28, 2012

Chair Leslie Miller called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance

Roll Call:

Present: Chair Leslie Miller, Roger Kilgore, and Kathy Rhoads

Approval of Minutes:

Kathy Rhoads made a motion to approve the minutes of October 24, 2012, as written and the motion was seconded by Roger Kilgore. Aye votes all.

Privilege of the Floor

Chief's Report:

Officer Eckstine presented a multi firearms class. Officers from the Sheriff's Department also attended. Chief Burson appreciates the benefits by sharing classes with other departments. Sgt. Schmoll will be teaching a standard field sobriety test and in March, Lt. Molnar will be holding a class on Subject Control Technique that the Seville Department Police Officers will be able to attend at no extra cost to the Village.

Officer Eckstine is currently at an armorer's school. This class is put on by Colt and will train Officer Eckstine to inspect and repair Colt weapons.

The Drug Drop Box in the lobby has collected 102 pounds of medication to date.

New Business:

Chair Miller has spoken with the Board of Elections and the Medina County Auditor and was able to collect information about putting a Police Levy on the ballot. Chair Miller is expecting numbers after the first of the year. At this time, Chair Miller is looking to put the levy on the November ballot.

Chair Miller mentioned the December Safety Committee Meeting is scheduled the day after Christmas. Kathy Rhoads made a motion to cancel the December 26th Safety meeting. Chair Miller seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Kathy Rhoads presented to update the Police Website and still keep it easily maintained. Concerns of displaying personal information were discussed. Chief Burson felt basic information would be valuable to the community.

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Old Business:

Chair Miller reported the Finance Committee voted to send the 2013 Budget to Council.

Kathy Rhoads reported Chief Burson had given her a tour of the new DVR Recording System that has been installed.

Chair Miller noted Officer Fockler checks both the AEDs and the emergency bags in the Police Cars once a month. Chair Miller had previously spoken with Chief Winkler with the Fire Department and Chief Winkler had offered to swap out any AED pads that were close to expiration. Officer Fockler had also told Chair Miller that everything has been upgraded to a 6.0.

Privilege of the Floor:

Barb Schwartz asked if there are any AEDs in the Parks and Streets Department. There are not any AEDs in the Department. This will be looked into.

Mrs. Rhoads will verify who services the first aid boxes in the Municipal building.

Mrs. Schwartz reported she had a discussion with Jim Carrick, Fiscal Officer. Mrs. Schwartz relayed for the 2014 budget Mr. Carrick feels the passage of a police levy would be vital and in 2015 it would be considered critical. The challenges of creating a committee for the support of the levy, and the replacement vs. renewal options were discussed.

A motion to adjourn the meeting by Kathy Rhoads and was seconded by Roger Kilgore. All were in favor. The meeting adjourned at 6:57 p.m.
