



*Seville Streets Committee Minutes
Wednesday, May 23, 2012*

The meeting was called to order at 7:55 p.m.

Roll Call:

Present: Chair Roger Kilgore, Kathy Rhoads, and Larry Landis.

Kathy Rhoads made a motion to approve the Streets Minutes of April 25, 2012, and Larry Landis seconded the motion. All were in favor. The minutes were approved as written.

Streets & Parks Commissioner's Report:

The attached report was submitted by Jon Sobczak.

Kathy Rhoads reported that Mr. Tomion on Elmwood Drive said thank you for fixing the street.

Privilege of the Floor:

Barb Schwartz inquired about the street in front of Jane's flower shop having a drainage issue. Mr. Sobczak reported that it will be corrected by the State next year including the aprons.

New Business:

Mrs. Boomhower inquired about the status of the new employees that were to be hired for the Parks and Streets Department. Chair Kilgore explained The Village had over 120 applications and the Mayor, Chair Kilgore, and Mr. Sobczak are going through the process. There was a discussion about the pay scale.

Old Business:

Resolution 2012-01 was passed last month and is going well.

June 21st and June 22nd is scheduled for the grindout for the asphalt repairs. Weather permitting this should be a four day project.

Chair Kilgore asked Mr. Sobczak to talk with Denny Eschler. Mr. Eschler offered last year asphalt grindings for \$4 a ton.

Mr. Sobczak can get a 2013 truck complete at state price for \$117,663. Mr. Sobczak is working with the Cloverleaf School District to purchase The Village's old truck for \$33,000. An Ordinance would need to be drawn. The time frame for the truck would be several months. Chair Kilgore made a motion to go to Council to purchase the International dump truck. Kathy Rhoads seconded the motion. All were in favor.

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Old Business (con't):

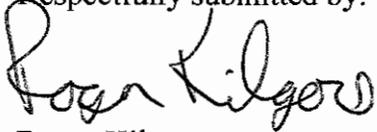
Mr. Sobczak spoke with a State Bridge Engineer who will take a look and advise on what direction to go for the Liberty Street bridge. There was a discussion on some options once the condition of the bridge is determined.

Mr. Sobczak and Leslie Miller are working on a proposal for grants on Friday for the ADA Ramps. The Department has 10 - 12 ADA ramps in the budget. There was a discussion to stay proactive with installation.

The temporary walkway structure on Rte. 3 is being checked on by ODOT. There was a discussion on safety of the walkway.

Larry Landis made a motion to adjourn the meeting and was seconded by Chair Kilgore. All were in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 8:32 p.m.
