

DECEMBER STREETS REPORT

- 1. We've finished up the 2010 leaf season running the complete route 14 times throughout the village and distributing 45 loads of leaves to area landscapers.**
- 2. We've put up all holiday decorations down town with the help of some area businesses and their fine help.**
- 3. Repaired and replaced signage in the village.**
- 4. We've made all street department trucks ready for snow removal replacing and repairing anything that needed to be fixed before the snowstorms.**
- 5. We've plowed all village roadways and parking lots salting them as needed and shoveling all village owned sidewalks, this dept. has currently used 91 tons of road salt at a cost of \$4229.68**
- 6. We've cold-patched pot holes on all village roadways using 400 lbs of asphalt material.**
- 7. Maysville contractors installed a new bay window for the current street dept. office. I spoke to Joseph Hostetler one of the owners**

of Curry Lumber (builders of both street dept. buildings and the rebuilding of the gazebo) about the need for a window in the street dept. office, he then made arrangements with his company to have it installed replacing an existing double door for the windows & installation at no cost to the village.

8. Maintenance all street department vehicles regularly and repairing as needed greasing regularly.

Paid all bills for the street department.

DECEMBER MAINTENANCE REPORT

Bought three strobe lights, one for the john deer gator, one for the backhoe, and one for the skidsteer loader, cost \$180.00 for all three lights.

Service the street dept. F550 ford dump truck estimated cost \$139.00

Service The 4900 INT. dump truck, for street dept. the low air pressure switch went bad, replaced it with a new one, and the ignition switch, pigtail shorted out, replaced them a long with a fuseholder, also replaced a Hydraulic coupling, put a new mushroom shoe assembly, and a mushroom shoe, cutting blade on the plow total cost \$1096.72 for all the parts.

Service the street dept. F150 ford pickup truck, cost \$27.00

The case 1845C loader, did a oil changed service on it and wired up a power

unit for the strobe light, estimated cost
\$78.44

The parks truck, F250 Ford, did a oil
change service on it, cost \$26.31

The john deer gator, I wired up a
power unit for the new strobe light estimated
cost \$20.00
