
The purpose of the meeting is for a Use Variance to allow Mollard Conducting Baton's to manufacture and sell conducting batons at 3 East Main Street. The property is currently zoned Commercial and the Commercial Code presently does not allow any manufacturing.

Mrs. Mollard was present. She explained that the company has been in business for twenty-nine years. They have been located in Bath for the last twelve years. They have three full time and five part time employees. The hours of operation would be from 6:00 A.M. until 4:00 P.M. The sawdust from the process is self contained and there is very little noise.

They are hoping to buy the building and fix it up to have a unique store front.

The business is actually more of an assembly process. The only manufacturing is the wood portion of the baton.
