Council Minutes

Mayor Sulzener called the meeting to order at 7:15 PM.

Present: Rick Stallard (President), Carol Carter, Kathy Rhoads, Larry Landis, Leslie Miller

Absent: Dennis Barrington

It was explained that the resolution on the agenda was to use State of Ohio up-dated wording in the resolution in order to put the police levy on the ballot. The previously submitted resolution lacked the required wording.

Legislation under consideration:

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF SEVILLE, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO REPEALING RESOLUTION 2014-10 AND PLACING A REPLACEMENT LEVY ON THE NOVEMBER 4, 2014 BALLOT WHICH IS A POLICE PROTECTION OPERATING EXPENSE LEVY INCREASING IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO (2) MILLS FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE (5) YEARS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The first reading was completed.

Mr. Stallard moved to add emergency language to resolution 2014-17. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Rhoads. Voting for the motion were Mrs. Rhoads, Mr. Stallard, Mrs. Miller, and Mr. Landis. Mrs. Carter voted against the motion.

A point of order was introduced as to the number of votes required for emergency language to be added.

The solicitor checked on the voting requirements for emergency language. Mr. Landis noted that 4 votes were required for emergency language. Mrs. Carter said she did not want to hold up putting the proposed levy on the ballot on a technicality since Council had previously approved putting the levy on the ballot and this resolution was an adjustment to the original wording.

Mr. Stallard moved to reconsider putting emergency language on resolution 2014-17. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Miller. The motion passed unanimously.

Mrs. Miller moved to add emergency language to resolution 2014-17. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Rhoads. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Stallard moved to suspend the three reading rule for resolution 2014-17. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Miller. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Stallard moved to adopt resolution 2014-17. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Rhoads. The motion passed unanimously.


