ORDINANCE NO. 2011-37

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF SEVILLE, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO AMENDING ORDINANCE 92-35 AS AMENDED, ESTABLISHING CERTAIN JOB DESCRIPTIONS FOR VILLAGE PERSONNEL TO ESTABLISH THE JOB DESCRIPTION FOR PART TIME ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT OF THE VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

This was the first reading.
