Privilege of the floor

Mrs. Schwartz asked about the procedures for payments of the utility bills. Mr. Lesiak explained that the Seville Methodist Church would be responsible for the first one hundred dollars of the utility bills and Mr. and Mrs. Boomhower would be responsible for anything over the one hundred dollar church limit.

Mrs. Schwartz also noted that The Village is responsible for informing the County Auditor that the usage of the building is changing. The State of Ohio will decide if the village will lose its' "Tax Exempt" status. If the "Tax Exempt" status is lost, the taxes will be \$881.33 per half year. While there is only a slim chance of losing the current status, Mrs. Schwartz said it needs to be part of the minutes so everyone is aware of the potential change.
