Finance Committee Minutes

Mr. Landis called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM.

Present: Larry Landis (Chairman), Brad Demiter, Leslie Miller, Rick Stallard, Kathy Rhoads

Mrs. Miller moved to approve the minutes from 05-18-2015. The motion was seconded by Mr. Demiter. The motion passed unanimously with the exception of Mrs. Miller who abstained.

Privilege of the floor:
None

The Fiscal Officer presented the May financial statements. There have been inquiries about the balance in the General Fund. The possibility that \$156,000.00 in inheritance taxes would need to be repaid inflated the General Fund balance by that amount. The Village Council has been very conservative over the past few years when estimating revenues and appropriations. Revenues are ahead of projections for 2015 and this has increased the General Fund balance through the end of May. The Council has also allowed for "emergency" contingencies in several categories particularly in wages for the Police and Street/Park Departments. So far the money has not been needed but a sudden major summer storm or a heavy December snow could require some of the "Emergency" appropriation to be used. If the money is not appropriated there could be a shortfall of funds at a critical time for the Village. If the appropriation is not needed it becomes part of the carry-over balance for the following year. The Council looks at the past several years of revenues and appropriations and does not over-react to sudden spikes in either case.

Ordinances under consideration:

Ordinance 2014-09 was tabled on 04-14-2014 pending funding. The Finance Committee and the Government Committee have recommended the ordinance remain tabled.
