The August financial statements were presented to the committee. It was noted that the fund balances for both Fund 2011 and 2271 should be adequate for the remainder of 2015. There may need to be another small transfer in December to cover expenses. Fund 4901 has a large balance but that is because several bills for street projects have not arrived yet. Revenue from the income tax is down from 2014 but this was expected and is still within the 2015 budget. The guest tax is up for 2015 and an increase in the budgeted amount for 2016 may be possible. MVL registration revenue is also exceeding budget expectations. An increase for 2016 is possible. The liability insurance appropriations have not been used so far. The bill will not be available until October. The building repair appropriation does not include the bill for the demolition of the house on West Main. The bill should be arriving soon as the work is now completed.
