Call to Order:

Chair Leslie Miller called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Approval of Minutes:

Brad Demiter made a motion to approve the Safety Meeting Minutes of December 9, 2015, and the motion was seconded by Chair Leslie Miller. Aye votes all. The minutes were approved as written.

Chief of Police, Don Burson, was sworn in by Mayor Carter.

Chief's Report:

Chief Burson has reported that all of the Seville Police Department Officers have served the community professionally and have all returned home safely. Chief Burson reviewed the 2015 Year End Report. A copy is attached.

Chief Burson reported one of the new cars is equipped and the second one will be completed this weekend. The new police cars are all wheel drive and provide extra room that is appreciated. The Rittman Police Department has voiced an interest in receiving the 2006 Crown Victoria. Mr. Lesiak is preparing an ordinance. In return the Village of Seville Police Department would receive firearm training from Rittman's Officer, Chris Cerino.

Chief Burson reported the Medina County Sheriff's Department has switched their radios to a digital system. Chief Burson will start budgeting money to allow purchase of new digital radios.

Chief Burson asked for permission to replace the back door that is rusted and swollen in the garage. He was given permission to replace the door after a second quote is received. The radios for the Parks & Streets Department have been delivered and programmed.

Chair Miller expressed appreciation on behalf of the Board of Public Affairs for the new cameras in the lobby.

Pending Legislation

Ordinance 2015-58 is the Memorandum of Understanding with Medina County Job & Family Services. Council passed on January 11, 2016

Ordinance 2015-59 is the contract with Lexipol for provisions to the Police Policy Manuals and training. Council passed on December 14, 2015, with emergency language.

Old Business:

Chief Burson reported he sent out 88 electronic surveys to surrounding counties in regards to salaries and benefits. To date nine surveys have been completed.

During the reporting period the Seville Police Department logged 46072 activities, complaints, assists and business checks. Of these complaints, a total of 1034 were traffic related, being a traffic offense, a parking violation or a motor vehicle crash. These complaints resulted in officers issuing a total of 124 citations. A summary of the periods activity is included below.

2015 Highlights:

In 2015, all of your officers returned from their tours safely, something that 129 chiefs across the country did not get to say. 2015 saw the retirement of Ssg. Reed after 24 years of service. We welcomed Adam Houck who passed his probationary period and we welcomed Nick Banks.

In 2015, we added a Yamaha Grizzly ATV and its associated equipment to our inventory through fundraisers put on by the police officers and volunteers. To this date, Seville is the only department in the county to have a piece of equipment like this available.

Officers attended training in the following areas: Use of force, Taser, attended a driving simulator, attended a shooting simulator, Pursuit driving, laws of arrest, various firearms training, driver's instructors certification, Reid interviewing, crimes against children, crisis conflict, responding to sexual assaults, basic first aid, CPR, first line supervision, credit card fraud, domestic violence, cultural diversity and fraud involving the elderly.

We had some help from some really great people and volunteers. Thank you. And finally, your police officers raised over \$700 for the Shop With A Cop campaign. What a great community!






