Call to Order:

Approval of Minutes:

Chief's Report:

Chief Burson has reported that all of the Seville Police Department Officers have served the community professionally and have all returned home safely.

Chief Burson reported the department helped with fingerprinting the new kindergarten registration in collaboration with Kiwanis, Westfield and Lodi. An officer also helped with Career Day randomly picking children to pay speeding tickets and go to court all while balancing their budget and job. The Department will also participate in the mock crash in April at Cloverleaf High School. The Westfield Fire Department and the drama club put a lot of effort into this event. The students will watch a film; walk outside to the crash witnessing the results, then escorted to the football stadium and walk through stations including an ER, officers giving notifications to family members, Waite and Sons Funeral Home talk about funeral expenses and Mrs. Carleton talks about the tragic loss of her son. An officer will also be chaperoning on Prom night.

CPR classes have been completed and more arrangements can be made as necessary.

Chief Burson said they were able to charge a subject for the turf incident at Cy Hewit Park. The subject plead guilty. The Village will ask for restitution. An officer was able to find a driver charged with a hit and run. A part was left behind at the scene and they were able to find the make and model and check drivers of that model.

Old Business:


Chief Burson reported the employee package research is still in progress to help retain officers.
