



**Safety Committee Minutes  
Monday, November 21, 2016**

**Call to Order:**

Chair Leslie Miller called the meeting to order at 7:25 p.m.

**Roll Call:**

Present: Chair Leslie Miller, Kathy Rhoads and Brad Demiter

**Approval of Minutes:**

Kathy Rhoads made a motion to approve the Safety Meeting Minutes of October 17, 2016, and the motion was seconded by Brad Demiter. Kathy Rhoads and Brad Demiter votes aye and Chair Leslie Miller abstained. The minutes were approved as written.

**Privilege of the Floor:**

Kevin Bittaker, Superintendent, for the Board of Public Affairs, presented information on updating the water pressure for the Village. The current water and sewer lines are from 1938. The new project would cost the Village \$5,200.00 a month for an annual cost of \$62,400 for 20 years. Different ideas of how to work the budget to pay for the project were discussed. The project start date goal is June 2017. The streets involved would be Route 3, Homestead, part of High and part of West Main. The information will be further discussed at the next Finance Meeting.

**Chief's Report:**

Chief Burson reported that all of the Seville Police Department Officers have served the community professionally and have all returned home safely. There has been a ten percent increase in officer deaths this year. Chief Burson was proud to say the department was able to get suspects to confess to a vandalized structure in town. The prosecutor, Kris Immel, provided training for OVI updates. Officer Houck completed two armourer courses and is now certified to inspect and repair the department weapons. The Grand Prix is still in process of being sold. Bids will be accepted until November 28th. Halloween went well with no issues.

**New Business:**

Mr. Demiter suggested the Wi-Fi password be changed.

Chair Miller informed the Committee Chief Burson reviewed the proposed state bicycle route and did not see any additional safety concerns with the proposal.

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Pending/Completed Legislation

2016-42 - Ordinance related to contracts with the highest and best bidder on the internet for the sale of Village property no longer needed - a 2004 Pontiac Grand Prix. Council passed on October 24<sup>th</sup>. The last day to accept bids is November 28<sup>th</sup>.

2016-55 - Ordinance for the 2016 Model Ohio Municipal Code published by the American Legal Publishing Corp. The second reading was November 14<sup>th</sup>.

Old Business:

The Budget for 2017 will be reviewed in the next Finance meeting in December.

Privilege of the Floor:

None.
