Call to Order:

Chair Leslie Miller called the meeting to order at 6:55 p.m.

Roll Call:

Approval of Minutes:

Kathy Rhoads made a motion to approve the Safety Meeting Minutes of August 21, 2017, and the motion was seconded by Chair Leslie Miller. Aye votes all. The minutes were approved as written.

Privilege of the Floor:

Mr. Dennis Gordon expressed his appreciation for the officers' work with the Run for the Trails.

Chief's Report:

Sgt. Scott Phillips reported the new officer, Taylor Deal, has worked his first 40 hours and it is going well.

Officer Banks presented the Committee with a cart full of firearms that have been accumulated through the streets of the Village of Seville. One of Officer Banks' duties is to be the firearms instructor for the department. Officer Banks is asking for permission to update the 25 year old guns the officers currently carry. Officer Banks would like to purchase 1911 TRPs for the department. The FBI and Special Forces carry this gun. He said one of the advantages to the new gun, in addition to reliability, is the mounted light rail. The Department will use the weapons toward trade in and money received from a sale of a car for purchase of the new guns. The difference would \$4,100. There was a discussion about the other guns and their ages.

Chair Miller made a motion to support Ordinance 2017-47 for the trade of firearms toward new firearms for the Police Department. Mrs. Rhoads seconded the motion. Aye votes all.

2017-49 – Ordinance to change number of full time police officers to be employed. First reading was on September 11th.

2017-53 – Ordinance increasing the spending limits for Police, Parks, Streets, and Fiscal Office Departments. First reading was on September 11th.
