Pending/Completed Legislation

2017-46 - Ordinance to use the 2018 Model Ohio Municipal Code Published by the American Legal Publishing Corp. Second reading was on October 10th.

2017-47 - Ordinance to contract to trade village property no longer needed for municipal purposes (firearms). Council passed on October 10th.

2017-49 - Ordinance to change number of full time police officers to be employed. Second reading was on October 10th.

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Pending/Completed Legislation (continued)

2017-53 – Ordinance increasing the spending limits for Police, Parks, Streets, and Fiscal Office Departments. Council passed on October 10th.

2017-61 – Ordinance to contract with the Medina County Sheriff's Office for sharing of Criminal Justice information. First reading was on October 10th.

Old Business:


The budget is a work in progress.
