2017 In Review

General

- All officers have returned safely from their tours
- We had 0 time missed due to injury
- Department wide we utilized the equivalent of only 8 sick days
- For several months we worked as a five man department with no change to the services we provided
- Loss of another veteran officer altered the make-up of the department in that his replacement was a new officer. Average time of service is now 1.8 years (excluding Chief and Sergeant).

Significant Offenses

- Officers did reports for 315 offenses
- 48 of those offenses were felony offenses
 - 12 Felony of the 5th degree
 - 9 Felony of the 4th degree
 - 13 Felony of the 3rd degree
 - 3 Felony of the 2nd degree
 - 9 Felony of the 1st degree (19%)
 - (2 are unclassified)
- 3 Sexual assaults involving the offenses of
 - Rape
 - Sexual Battery
 - Unlawful Sexual Contact with a minor
 - Gross Sexual Imposition
 - Stalking
 - *One suspect has been arrested on a 100+ count indictment
 - *All incidents involve family or relatives. None reported involve strangers
- Robbery behind 17 Electric Street
 - An aggravated robbery involving two victims and several suspects
 - Aggravated robbery
 - Kidnapping
 - Multiple drug offenses
- Recovery of, and arrest for stolen motor vehicle
- BMT Firearms break-in
- Break in at Sommers
 - DNA evidence collected and matched
