Chief's Report:

Chief Burson reported that all of the Seville Police Department Officers have served the community professionally and have all returned home safely. The department has one officer off for two weeks, leaving the department shorthanded. Upcoming training includes firearm training, a sexual assault evaluation class, and an evidence tech training class.

Chief Burson reported for the month of March the department had 35 new offenses, 68 traffic offenses, 2 missing persons, and 57 assists to Board of Public Affairs, Fire or EMS.

New Business:

Mr. & Mrs. Hantzsche came to the meeting to thank Chief Burson and Jon Sobczak for getting the snow ban concerns explained. Mr. Sobczak explained the merchants were concerned with the snow building up on the sidewalks after the streets were plowed. Mr. Sobczak said he had a skid steer with a snow bucket to use next winter to help alleviate the snow build up on the sidewalks.

2018-08 is an ordinance to contract with Medina County Sheriff's Office for dispatch service. The ordinance was tabled April 9, 2018. Chair Miller noted the invoice was \$855 less than 2017.
