Call to Order:

Chair Leslie Miller called the meeting to order at 6:59 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance

Roll Call:

Approval of Minutes:

Brad Demiter made a motion to approve the Safety Meeting Minutes of April 16, 2018, and the motion was seconded by Sue Frey. Two aye votes. Mr. Demiter abstained. The minutes were approved as written.

Privilege of the Floor:

Due to a time restriction, Kevin Bittaker presented information on Autumn Meadows and inquired if the build out should have a cul-de-sac or a stub street. After a discussion about the park trail and safety, the general consensus was a cul-de-sac was recommended for the development.

Chief's Report:

Chief Burson reported that all of the Seville Police Department Officers have served the community professionally and have all returned home safely. There have been 55 in the line-of-duty deaths to date. The Seville Police Department had two officers at the Memorial downtown Cleveland during Police Week. Officer Houck and Officer Searle helped place markers at graves.

The Medina Sea of Youth presentation had over 800 people in attendance. All of the departments in Medina County were presented with a recognition plaque.

The Department attended a two day hand gun training from an instructor in Wadsworth. Officer Banks is finishing his second week in evidence tech training. Chief Burson said the yard sale preparation will begin.

Chief Burson reported for the month of March the department had 22 new offenses, 65 traffic offenses, 0 missing persons, and 53 assists to Board of Public Affairs, Fire or EMS.
