Mr. John Clevidence informed the Committee that he is putting together a group that will raise funds to purchase an All Terrain Vehicle and a trailer for the Village. The group will attempt to raise \$9,000 which is the approximate purchase price of the vehicle and trailer. No government money would be needed. Old business:

Bids for the rental of the former Clerk's office on Main Street are being taken until noon on November 28<sup>th</sup>.

There was a discussion concerning the purchase of new police cruisers. Mrs. Rhoads made a motion to recommend to council that 3 new police cars be purchased. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Schwartz. Mrs. Schwartz, Mr. Barbera and Mrs. Rhoads voted for the motion. Mr. Lovejoy voted against the motion. A check for \$12750 has been received for the damaged police car. There will be additional money available when the new car is outfitted. The two non-operating cars will be salvaged by the insurance company.

The Seville Food Pantry has vacated 6 Spring Street. The utilities have been turned off as of November 1<sup>st</sup>. The keys still need to be accounted for.

The demolition of the house at 83 West Main has run into a problem. The EPA report revealed that there is asbestos on the roof and siding. This will increase the estimate from Kent's Excavating. A new estimate will need to be submitted.

There were no bids for the Information Technology work.

Departmental budgets are complete and ready for review at the appropriate committee meetings.
