

**Village of Seville

New Business:

Kathy Rhoads asked about paving the streets in the Elmwood Drive and Oakwood Streets area. Jon said that they use Jim Venus for concrete street repair. There was discussion on what streets are in need of repair. Kilgore suggested that Jon contact Jim Lytle for asphalt street repair. Jon said that is who they have been using in the past. Jon told the Committee that he had talked with Jim Carrick regarding the State Highway Funds. B. Schwartz confirmed that the fund has \$160,000 in it for road repair.



April street report 2010

- 1. The dept. is currently painting all of the road markings in the village, crosswalks, stop bars ext. and any other line painting necessary to the village.**
- 2. We have been filling in the potholes throughout the village. We have used 2000 lbs of cold patch materials this month cost \$1900.**
- 3. The dept. using Westfield's mower cut all trees and brush that restrict the drivers view along our roadways. We do this annually for sight distance purposes**
- 4. Streets dept. runs the street sweeper on all of our curbed streets including the down town area weekly or as needed. We pick up trash along the roadways as often as we can.**
- 5. We pulled the three parking signs at CY Hewitt Park and relocated them along**

the driveway so that they can be more easily seen.

6. Streets dept. repairs and replaces village signs as needed.

7. We hung all of the flags in both our parks and public buildings with new ones.

**8. (Spring cleaning for the street dept.)
Cleaned up our shop of all snow removal equipment and other winter related items.**

There is no maintenance report this month other than the routine maintenance that we perform regularly on all of our equipment.
