Call to Order:

New Business:

Resolution 2012-01, Sidewalk Repair. Mr. Landis spoke with Roger Kilgore and Mr. Kilgore is not in favor of any brand new sidewalks this year. Mr. Kilgore would like to have all of the safety hazards replaced. Mr. Sobczak reported he is currently working on the sidewalk between Dollar General and El Patron. Mr. Sobczak was informed he will need to create an addendum with all of the parcel numbers of sidewalks that need work. Mr. Sobczak is working on it. This will be completed by the February meeting.

Mr. Landis spoke for Mr. Kilgore asking Mr. Sobczak for an idea of what streets really need work. Mr. Sobczak informed Mr. Landis that it was scheduled for last year and with all of the rain last year the asphalt companies were so far behind and we were placed on the back seat due to being smaller jobs. Mr. Sobczak was asked to work on planning a 5 year plan.

Old Business:

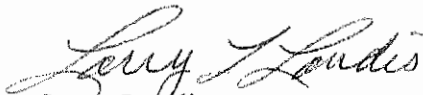
6 Spring Street. Mr. Sobczak has no use for the building. The bays could be utilized if there are no other uses.

Mr. Sobczak reported he had a notice from Matt Stineman, Head Administrator for the Department of Transportation for Medina County. The Department is going to shut down the State Route 3 bridge walk that is on the South side from where the ice cream shop is until next year when they resurface State Route 3. This is due to dilapidation of the steel guard rails. Mr. Sobczak asked Mr. Stineman about having the Geothermal plastic resin installed and will be researching on getting this done for the new crosswalk. Leslie Miller suggested this could be added to the Block Grant.

Leslie Miller made a motion to adjourn the meeting and was seconded by Kathy Rhoads. Aye votes all. The meeting was adjourned at 9:38 p.m.
