Provisions:

Operation of an alarm system without a valid alarm user’s permit is prohibited.
 Automatic dialing devices programmed to direct dial the Seville Police Department are prohibited.
 Local alarms may not resemble the sound of any emergency signal or civil defense alarm or siren.
 All Local alarms must have the capacity to reset themselves after a period of time not to exceed 15 minutes.
 The “Responsible Party” will be notified by certified mail upon the accumulation of three false alarms, that a fee will be imposed for additional false alarms at the location.
 Fire alarms are limited to manual pull stations, heat or smoke detectors and water flow on automatic sprinkler or standpipe systems.

Fees:

After the accumulation of tree false alarms, 48 hours or more apart within any twelve month period, a response fee will be imposed as follows:

- 4th alarm: \$100.00
- 5th alarm: \$150.00
- 6th alarm: \$200.00
- 7th alarm: **REVOCAION OF PERMIT**

Enforcement and Penalties:

Enforcement of any of the provisions of Ordinance 97-48 may be by civil action or criminal prosecution. The failure or omission t o comply with any section or provision of Ordinance 97-48 shall be deemed a violation. Whoever violates any provision of this chapter is guilty of “Alarm System Misconduct”, a misdemeanor of the third degree.

Local alarms: Those alarms which activate an audible signal within the proximity of the premises only.

False Alarms: Activation of an alarm system through mechanical failure, malfunction, improper installation, or the negligence of the owner or lessee of an alarm system or of his employees or agents. False alarms do not include alarms caused by hurricanes, tornadoes, earthquakes or other similarly violent conditions.
