Police Chief's Report

Officer Deal reported on behalf of Chief Burson. Officer Deal reviewed significant events and updates as well as statistics from the month of December.

Officer Gelles has completed his probationary period. Mr. Vierheller made a motion to end his probationary period and place him at a level 4 pay scale. *Role call: Miller – Aye, Demiter - Aye, Vierheller – Aye. Motion passes*

The current DVR system has been inconsistent, a quote of approximately \$3,000 was received from Securitec for the replacement and installation. It was questioned if that would be taken from the building maintenance or police department budget. Mr. Vierheller made a motion to get the cameras and proceed with Securitec. *Role call: Miller – Aye, Demiter - Aye, Vierheller – Aye. Motion passes* Details of which budget will be impacted will be settled at another time. There will be changes with Datamaster coming in 2024 and at this time the exact details are unknown. Officer Deal reported that a new ordinance regarding parking in the Village is also being sent out. The Council will review it and discuss that at the next meeting.


