Officer Deal also advised that juveniles have been riding their bikes in a reckless manner causing safety concerns and attempts to speak to the juveniles wasn't resolved the issue and the parents of the juveniles were also not helpful. Mrs. Miller made a motion in favor of having the Police Department speak with the Solicitor to draft an ordinance. The motion was seconded and carried. It was noted that the Committee is in favor of kids riding bikes but the reckless nature is a cause of concern.


