POLICE CHIEF'S REPORT: Chief Burson reported all officers returned from their tours safely. During January, the SPD logged 3515 activities, complaints, assists, and business checks. New significant events and updates for January included officers responding to a report of a person with an altered mental status, various traffic violations, school bus violations, sexual imposition, domestic disturbance, and officers assisted a local business in the recovery of a missing trailer. Chief reported the current breath testing machine will be retired at the end of this year as the State will no longer certify officers in its operation. A new breath testing machine with a ten-month lag time has been ordered, and officers are attending training in its operation.

Chief will task two officers to escort the families of fallen police officers at the National Police Office Memorial in Washington D.C. during Police week in May 12 through May 18, 2024. Officers raise money through fundraisers for room and board while the Chief tasks them with this responsibility as part of their regular work week. Officers greet the families of fallen officers who arrive at the airport and are then assigned to them for security and care, escorting them as they attend various functions. This will be our fourth year participating in this even, with new officers attending each year. Officer Kilgore started this activity and it has grown to include the Medina County Sheriff's office, Medina City and Montville Police departments.
