PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR: Amelia Cianciola of 110 Greenwich Rd. Unit 7 had a couple suggestions. She lives directly across Greenwich Road and even to come here tonight, she had to walk all the way down to El Patron to use the crosswalk. Is there any way to get a cross walk from the end of Royal Crest across to Bench Mark. Chief Burson said he would need to do some research. She also feels the stop lights downtown should be considered for no turn on red signs. People have to move up into the crosswalks to be able to see if safe to turn and we have people downtown walking all the time. Chief Burson will also look into this and schedule a Sign Committee Meeting to discuss these matters.

POLICE CHIEF'S REPORT: Chief Burson reported all officers returned from their tours safely. During the month of March, they logged 4061 activities with 67 of them being traffic related and some were assisting BOPA and Seville Fire and EMS. Officers participated in Active Shooter training at a business in Lodi. Two officers attended evidence training and all of our officers are now certified Evidence Technicians. Sergeant Banks attended Terminal Area Coordinator training on Leads. They also attended monthly in house training on policies and procedures. There were no incidents reported during the Eclipse. Streets added an additional stop sign at the intersection of Milton and Market for northbound traffic. The speed sign has been on Pleasant Street for over a month now. Data gathered from the sign has indicated it has had a positive effect. Based on the results gathered from this, a second sign has been authorized and will be moved from location to location. There has been an outstanding amount of support from the community for the upcoming DC Police Memorial and Chief Burson has tasked officer Houck and Gelles for this. Their trips have been paid all through donations. Chief reviewed significant events and updates for the month of March. New radios have been ordered for the department.
