SBR equipment will be purchased directly by the Village for contractor installation.
- 2. All work shall be completed within a reasonable timeframe as scheduled by the successful bidder, but will not begin prior to **April 1, 2025**, nor end after **December 1, 2026**. The Village reserves the right to dictate the construction duration as deemed necessary by the Village Council.
