They voted whether it should be emergency language or not and the vote was split. It will go to council as is to be voted on. They agreed to add 15 minutes as the allotted time to the ordinance to match other nuisance ordinances.

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-38

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-39

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF SEVILLE, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO ADOPTING A RANDOM TESTING PROCEDURE FOR THE SUBSTANCE USE PREVENTION AND RECOVERY PROGRAM.

There were questions regarding how this is different from the SUPR program that was adopted in the fall. The SUPR program that was adopted is a state wide program and this ordinance is to cover the Village's procedure how to follow through with the program. There was debate and clarification regarding roles of the Fiscal Officer and the department heads and regarding the 2-hour time window. The procedure is still in draft form.



- **New Business:** None
- **Old Business:**
 - **East Main Street** - Mr. Manges explained the process he is working with Mr. Burgoyne on trying to secure grants for this complex project. It will need to be approved though Council. He will forward the proposal to the village solicitor. They would like to begin surveys before foliage appears.
 - **Liberty Street Bridge** - Mr. Manges stated the bridge was previously on the state list to be repaired. The village missed the window to apply for grants. We have an opportunity to apply for the year 2027 which, if awarded, would cover 95% of the cost. The grant

application window closes around August. This will need an ordinance likely with emergency language

- **Privilege of the Floor:** Mrs. Gray explained to Council the importance of the SUPR program that was being debated earlier. She stated if we choose not to follow through with these state funded programs, we would be unable to receive grants from the state. This is extremely important to the all the departments at the Village. The administrative office did not make them up or the rules just to upset other departments. Mrs. Harper-Bigley stated regardless of individual opinions of the program or how it is presented, it is required by state since adopted by the village.
- **ADJOURN:** Mr. Eby made a motion to adjourn which was seconded and carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:39 pm.
