• **New Business:**

○ RITA/CCA discussion

- The committee discussed switching tax collection services from the Central Collection Agency (CCA) to the Regional Income Tax Agency (RITA).
- A local accounting firm reportedly has a positive working relationship with RITA.
- It was noted that the village currently pays CCA significant fees, and the consensus is that switching to RITA would be financially beneficial.
- A member requested data on recovery rates and expected costs before the next meeting to make an informed decision.
- Request and review RITA's data security breach coverage and response policy; confirm adequacy prior to any vote.

- Tax collection court fees
 - Members discussed whether to pursue collections when the filing fee exceeds the owed amount.
 - The members will request more information from the Village Solicitor
- **Old Business:**
 - Seville Yard Sales
 - Members discussed public feedback on the village yard sales.
 - Primary concerns include rule enforcement during the event: illegal parking, improper sign placement, and leaving unsold items on tree lawns.
 - The Police Chief stated that early education and enforcement on Thursday, as setups begin, is the most effective approach.
 - A plan was discussed to create an illustrative guide or Google Site with event rules, to be shared on social media.
 - The fire department may be asked to post about parking rules to emphasize access for emergency vehicles.
