



GOVERNMENT COMMITTEE REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

- Call to order at 7:00 p.m.

- Mr. Eby made a motion to approve minutes from 07/06/26. The motion was seconded Upon Roll Call: YEAS: *Bartosch, Brilla, Eby, Gordon, Miller* NAYS: *None*. Minutes were approved as written.
- **Amendments to the agenda:** Mrs. Miller made a motion to add Judge Lewis to the agenda for new business but to speak before Privilege of the floor. The Motion was seconded and approved.

Judge Lewis presented the 2025 year-end report for the Wadsworth Municipal Court, which serves the southern portion of Medina County, including Seville. This included case statistics, a new court security checkpoint, court activity and updates to technology.

- **Privilege of the floor:** Mr. Brilla noted there has been some talk among residents and there are some concerns regarding data centers coming to the Village of Seville. He thanked everybody for coming to the meeting. He stated the best way to get information is coming to the meetings. There are different committee meetings the first four Mondays of the month. He stated the Village is not interested in a data center at this time. The Village has not been approached about one. Discussion like these take years of planning. If you come to the meetings, we will tell you the truth and we are here to listen and work the residents of Seville.
 - Missy Reig of 148 Royal Crest Drive. She asked for more details regarding Ordinance 2026-58 which will have it's first reading. A copy will be sent for her to review. She also passed out information she acquired regarding data centers after the mayor requested more information at last week's Zoning meeting. She stated this would give members time to review before the Council Meeting. She stated she is against data centers coming to the Village.
 - Pauline Chapman of 7328 Wooster Pike has concerns about data centers and the amount of water they use. The state of Ohio needs to be worried about this in general because she feels our water is already in jeopardy. She is against having data centers.
